POSITIVE BEHAVIOUR FOR LEARNING

Positive Behaviour For Learning is built on the foundation that...

Positive behaviour can be learnt and difficult and disruptive behaviour can be unlearnt.

The focus is on:...

- preventing problem behaviour
- developing students' social skills
- reinforcing desired behaviour
- consistently addressing and reducing problem behaviours
- using data based assessment to inform our teaching and learning

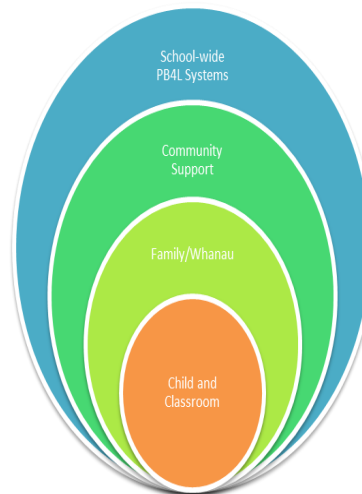


BEHAVIOURS

Minor and Major behaviours have been clearly defined through consultation with students, parents, community and staff.

Incident Forms - If a student has a minor or major incident, staff are encouraged to complete a form and place in the designated tray. If a major incident has occurred management will deal with it, within 24 hours.

The benefits of school, whānau/family and community partnerships are a valuable component of PB4L and contribute towards our students SOARING into the future with confidence.



REWARDS and ACKNOWLEDGEMENTS

are a core feature of building a positive school culture.

POSITIVE REINFORCEMENTS occur in many ways at Manukorihi Intermediate.

- Distribution of SOAR awards in class, the playground, (and sometime soon in our community)
- Weekly/Fortnightly and Monthly student SOAR draws presented in Friday assemblies by our SmokeFree Leaders with students' names published in the school newsletter
- Term reward days for students who have not received a minimum of 8 minor or 2 major incidents per term
- One child from each class receives a Duffy Book Award of their choice which is presented each week in assembly
